Applications are invited for at least one anticipated tenure-track position (subject to approval and funding) in Mathematics, Operations Research or Statistics at the Assistant Professor level to start in August 2012. (This position exists in addition to another tenure track position dedicated solely to Operations Research or Statistics which the department is hoping to fill.) Hiring of an exceptional candidate at the rank of Associate Professor may be considered. Candidates must have a Ph.D. in Mathematics, Statistics, Operations Analysis or closely related fields, demonstrate a strong commitment to undergraduate teaching, and show potential to continue an active scholarly program. All fields of research will be considered. Promotion and tenure evaluations follow the American Association of University Professors guidelines.

The Mathematics Department at the U. S. Naval Academy consists of 42 civilians with Ph.D.'s and 18 military officers typically with Masters Degrees. Full summer research support is usually available for the first three years of new appointments. In addition, USNA continues to provide partial research support in the form of matching funds for research collaborations with DoD, government, and industry laboratories. Faculty members receive full federal government service benefits. Applications will be evaluated starting in mid-January.
