

## **Postdoctoral Position in Partial Differential Equations**

Applications are invited for a postdoctoral research fellowship (subject to approval and funding) in mathematics to start in August 2012. This position is intended for a mathematical scientist at an early career stage with research interests in Applied Analysis, Partial Differential Equations, or Scientific Computation. Additional preference will be given to candidates with a specific focus in Kinetic Theory. The initial appointment is for one year with a likely extension to two years pending approval, funding, and a positive performance review. Full summer research support may also be available. Candidates must have a Ph.D. in the Mathematical Sciences or a similar discipline and demonstrate strong potential to develop an active scholarly program. Candidates must be permanent residents or U.S. citizens.
