Subj: MIDSHIPMAN FOR A DAY PROGRAM

1. Purpose. To promulgate the policy and procedures for the Midshipman for a Day program.
2. Background. The Midshipman for a Day program is designed to give Naval Academy faculty and staff a better understanding of the daily responsibilities placed on midshipmen. Participating faculty and staff shadow an approved midshipmen escort through a normal schedule day, attending all required formations, meals and classes.
3. Policy
 - a. Participation: Only USNA faculty and extended staff may participate in the Midshipman for a Day program.
 - b. Midshipmen Escorts: Only First or Second Class Midshipmen may serve as escorts for the Midshipman for a Day Program. Escorts will be selected by the Academic Dean, reviewed by the midshipmen's company officer and approved by the Commandant of Midshipmen.
4. Procedure
 - a. Initial Muster: Midshipman and the Faculty and Staff are mustered in the Rotunda at 0715 on the day of tour to ensure that all participants and escorts are paired up. Pairings are made prior to this time by the Midshipman Coordinator.
 - b. Daily Schedule: Midshipmen for a Day will follow their specific midshipman's schedule from 0715 to 1800. The typical schedule of events is as follows:

0715-0745	Breakfast in King Hall
0755-1145	1 st through 4 th Period Classes
1200-1215	Noon Meal Formation (Faculty and Staff will view from Tecumseh for outside formation)
1215-1320	Lunch in King Hall
1330-1530	5 th and 6 th Period Classes
1530-1800	Post class activities/faculty and staff depart

c. Departure: Faculty and Staff may decide with escorts which post-class activities they would like to see (i.e. intramurals, sports team practices), not to extend through evening meal.
