COMMANDANT OF MIDSHIPMEN NOTICE 1000

Subj: VISIT OF NAVAL ACADEMY PREPARATORY SCHOOL (NAPS)  
CANDIDATES TO THE U.S. NAVAL ACADEMY, 17-21 OCTOBER 2007

1. Purpose. To promulgate a schedule for the NAPS candidates' visit and assign responsibilities for associated events.

2. Information. During the period 17-21 October, approximately 265 NAPS candidates will be guests of the Brigade of Midshipmen. These candidates will be billeted in Bancroft Hall and will observe as closely as possible the routine of their escorts, except as modified by enclosure (1).

3. Action.

a. CAPT Gary H. Williams, USN, Operations Officer, is the visit coordinator. He can be contacted through LCDR Ryan Miller, Assistant Operations Officer, extension 3-7126.

b. Midshipman Mark Pulley (Brigade Operations Officer), and Midshipman Natalie Blandon (2<sup>nd</sup> Regimental Operations Officer), are the Midshipmen-in-Charge of the evolution.

c. The Naval Academy Athletic Association will select fourth class Midshipmen to host varsity recruits, and the Midshipmen-in-Charge of NAPS visit will select Midshipmen from the same class to host all other NAPS candidates. Company officers and Battalion officers will review the proposed escort list to ensure the proper Midshipmen hosts are being selected. Final approval authority of Midshipmen hosts will be the Operations Officer.

d. Candidates are guests of the Brigade and will be treated as such. Escorts will observe the normal routine during the period 17-21 October. Escorts should be available throughout the entire visit period (e.g., not on restriction, weekend, MO, etc.). The escorts must stay with NAPS candidates during the

entire visit, unless permission to deviate is received from their NAPS officer chain of command. Candidates will observe study period and accompany escorts to various study areas, including Nimitz Library. NAPS students may be authorized permission, via their officer chain of command, to attend NAPS sponsored tutorials by NAPS faculty during study hour.

e. Room assignments and candidate/escort assignments may not be changed unless authorized by the Operations Officer. Taps reports will be forwarded to the Bancroft Hall Officer of the Watch who will coordinate with NAPS Command Duty Officer (CDO). NAPS CDO cell phone number is 401-641-4809.

f. Company Operations Officers will pick up cots in the 1<sup>st</sup> LT Storage Room, 4B08, fourth wing basement on 15 October. Hours of operation are 0700-1330. Escorts will pick up cots from Company Operations Officers and place in rooms prior to 1600 on 17 October.

g. NAPS candidates will eat with their hosts in King Hall or Dahlgren Hall. Although NAPS candidates are not responsible for 4/C rates, fourth class escorts will be responsible for fourth class rates.

h. Town liberty for NAPS candidates will not commence until Saturday, 20 October after "Blue and Gold" at the end of the Wake forest football game. Liberty will expire for all NAPS candidates and Midshipmen escorts at 2400 on Saturday, 20 October.

i. Midshipmen hosts will ensure NAPS candidates abide by Midshipmen Regulations and comply with the schedule delineated in enclosure (1). They will be expected to adhere to all requirements placed on fourth class Midshipmen, to include liberty constraints and fourth class taps. Fourth class escorts will neither "chop" nor "sound off" while escorting NAPS candidates; however, they will stay in the center of the passage way and abide by all military courtesies.

j. NAPS candidates will visit classes on Thursday, 18 October from 0755 to 1145. They will attend tours on Friday, 19 October, from approximately 0830 to 1150. prior to escorting a NAPS visitor to class, Midshipmen hosts must obtain approval from appropriate instructor(s). NAPS candidates will wear khaki uniforms Thursday and Friday. During all formations, including Thursday noon inspection, NAPSTERS will integrate into respective squads.

k. NAPS candidates will attend the NAVY JV versus NAPS football game on Friday. If they choose to attend the parade, they will go directly from the football game in SDBs.

l. NAPS candidates will muster in T-court at 1145 on Saturday, 20 October and march over to the stadium as a unit behind the 30<sup>th</sup> Company for the Wake Forest football game. Upon reaching the stadium staging area, the NAPS candidates will be dismissed and will enter the stadium via Gate D. they will be seated in Section 108 in Rows 1-6 (1-11), Row 7-14 (1-10), Row 15-24 (1-15), Rows 31-32 (1-14). This section will be roped off and NAPSTERS will be escorted by the NAPS staff officers to their seats. NAPS candidates will not go onto the field to form a tunnel or do push ups.

m. Five NAPS candidates will be designated to pick up boxed lunches in King Hall for the return bus trip to NAPS on Sunday, 21 October, between 0630-0645, and bring them to the Mid Store parking lot prior to departure.

n. Company Officers and Midshipmen Company Commanders are responsible for ensuring compliance with all phases of this notice by the NAPS candidates in their respective companies.

o. Enclosure (2) is information for NAPS candidates and Midshipmen escorts.
