COMMANDANT OF MIDSHIPMEN NOTICE 1020

Subj: MIDSHIPMEN PROCEDURES FOR WARRIOR DAY UNIFORM

1. Purpose. To issue specific uniform guidance for 1/C Midshipmen participating in any designated "Warrior Day" during Spring Semester Academic Year 2012. This notice replaces the version dated 21 December 2011.
2. Background. In recognition of the Class of 2012 service assignments, the Commandant of Midshipmen has designated Friday as "Warrior Day." Participation in "Warrior Day" will entail appropriate wear of the uniform that represents a Midshipman's assigned warfare community (e.g., flight suit for aviation, digital cammies for USMC, etc.). "Warrior Day" Fridays will be recognized from post holiday reform until commencement of Spring Break.
3. Action. Midshipmen 1/C will wear the uniform appropriate to their respective warfare community.
 - a. Aviation. The regulation green Nomex flight suit is authorized. Flight suit will be worn zipped up with sleeves down or with one roll if desired. Flight boots or equivalent will be worn. Undershirt will be NWU blue t-shirt. A leather or cloth Velcro name tag will be worn on the left chest. No other patches are authorized. Khaki garrison cover will be worn outdoors or when otherwise appropriate.
 - b. Marine Corps. The Combat Utility Uniform (digital cammies) is authorized. Collar devices/rank insignia will be worn per reference (a). Brown side out boot is the only authorized footwear. Undershirt will be olive drab green crew neck. Name tapes indicating U.S. Navy will be worn above and adjacent to the left chest pocket. Name tape with last name will be worn above and adjacent to right chest pocket.

c. Submarine and Surface Warfare. Navy Blue Coveralls are authorized. Collar devices/rank insignia will be worn per reference (a). Coveralls will be worn with cotton khaki web belt and plain buckle. The black, polished work boot is the only appropriate footwear. Undershirt will be NWU blue t-shirt. Name tapes indicating last name will be worn over right chest pocket. Submarine selectees are authorized to wear the olive submarine sweater over their coveralls. A ship/submarine blue command ball cap approved by the Company Officer will be worn outdoors or when otherwise appropriate. The Navy Working Uniform (NWU) will also be authorized. NWUs will be worn with black plain steel toe boots, Navy blue cotton crewneck undershirt, and a khaki web belt. Insignia will be worn per reference (a).

d. SPECOPS/SPECWAR. NWUs (Type III) are authorized. Undershirt will be brown cotton t-shirt. Boots will be Navy-certified desert tan, brown brushless, or smooth black leather. The uniform will be worn with a coyote brown nylon woven riggers belt with subdued black finished buckle and an eight-point utility cap. Additional information regarding wear of the uniform is available in reference (b).

e. Other Communities. Wear of the Navy Working Uniform (NWU) is authorized. NWUs will be worn with black plain steel toe boots, Navy blue cotton crewneck undershirt, and a khaki web belt. Insignia will be worn per reference (a).

e. Foreign Nationals. Foreign National 1/C Midshipmen may wear appropriate uniform of their home country.

4. Authorized Wear

a. Midshipmen. "Warrior Day" uniform will only be worn on Fridays and only on the Yard. These uniforms are not authorized for outside formations, nor are they authorized at any other time during the week.

b. Commandant's Staff. Staff members are authorized to wear the respective "Warrior Day" uniform while in Bancroft Hall and, in accordance with reference (c), for short-term and appropriate stops while commuting to and from home, with the exception of Navy Blue Coveralls, which are only authorized in Bancroft Hall.
