COMMANDANT OF MIDSHIPMEN NOTICE 1020

Subj: MIDSHIPMEN PROCEDURES FOR WARRIOR DAY UNIFORM

Ref: (a) COMDTMIDNINST 1020.3A

1. Purpose. To issue specific uniform standard guidance for 1/C Midshipmen participating in any designated "Warrior Day".
2. Background. In recognition of the Class of 2009 service assignments, the Commandant of Midshipmen will designate Friday as "Warrior Day." Participation in "Warrior Day" will entail appropriate wear of the uniform that represents the Midshipmen's assigned warfare community (e.g. flight suit for aviation, digital cammies for USMC, etc.)
3. Action. Midshipmen 1/C will wear the uniform appropriate to their respective warfare community.

a. Aviation. The regulation green Nomex flight suit is authorized. Flight suit will be worn zipped up with sleeves down (except one roll permitted if desired). Flight boots or equivalent will be worn. Undershirt will be olive drab brown crew neck. A leather or cloth Velcro name tag will be worn on the left chest. Khaki garrison cover will be worn outdoors or when otherwise appropriate.

b. Marine Corps. The Combat Utility Uniform (digital cammies) is authorized. Collar devices / rank insignia will be worn per reference (a). Brown side out boot is the only authorized footwear. Undershirt will be olive drab green crew neck. Name tapes indicating U.S. Navy will be worn above and adjacent to the left chest pocket. Name tape with last name will be worn above and adjacent to right chest pocket. Camouflage Utilities may be worn as described in reference (a) until digital cammies are procured.

c. Submarine and Surface Warfare. Blue coveralls will be authorized. Collar devices / rank insignia will be worn per ref (a). Coveralls will be worn with cotton khaki web belt and plain

buckle. The black, polished work boot is the only appropriate footwear. Undershirt will be a white crew neck. Name tapes indicating U.S. Navy will be worn over left chest pocket. Name tape indicating last name will be worn over right chest pocket. A ship / submarine blue command ball cap approved by the Company Officer will be worn outdoors or when otherwise appropriate.

d. SPECOPS/SPECWAR. Camouflage Utilities may be worn in the manner described in reference (a).

e. Foreign National 1/C Midshipmen may wear an appropriate uniform of their home country.

f. Alternative uniform for all 1/C Midshipmen is working Khaki with miniature service assignment pin centered on left pocket flap ¼" below top.

4. "Warrior Day" uniforms will only be worn on the Yard. These uniforms are authorized for outside formations. Swords and sword belts will not be worn for formations on "Warrior Day." No outerwear is prescribed for these uniforms therefore, should cold weather dictate, Friday noon formations will be held indoors to support "Warrior Day" uniforms.
