Getting To Online Resources

Login to NKO (step not shown – login requires a user name and password or CAC – see the NKO site for more details)

- #1 Click REFERENCE
- #2 Click Econtent – Computers / IT
- #3 Click Safari or MyLibrary



Safari Registration

The first time you try to use Safari you will have to register - registration is a free, one-time requirement.

After you register, you will have to sign in any time you want to use Safari, and you will be able to access Safari directly (you will not have to login to Navy Knowledge Online each time to use Safari).
