The Armel-Leftwich Visitor Center and Naval Academy Gift Shop are open from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. At the Visitor Center, daily tours are given from 10 a.m.-3 p.m. Monday through Friday, 9:30 a.m.-3 p.m. on Saturday and noon-3 p.m. on Sunday. Stop by to see the exhibit, *USNA Graduates in Space*, which accompanies the Freedom 7 space capsule, and the new displays on the second deck. Midshipmen and their parents receive a 10% discount at the Gift Shop.

Dahlgren Hall's Drydock Restaurant (410-293-2873) is open from 8 a.m. until 10 p.m. May 19-24. On Friday, May 25, it will be open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. The Drydock serves breakfast, fast food, pizza, sandwiches, and salads.

Concession stands are available offering fast food and souvenirs on Monday, May 21, at the Worden Field Gazebo; around the Yard on Tuesday, May 22, for the Blue Angels rehearsal, Wednesday, May 23, during the Blues' formal flight demonstration and on Thursday, May 24 at the Worden Field Gazebo. During the day, Monday-Thursday, May 21-24, a food stand will be open 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. in the Midshipmen Store parking lot.

The U.S. Naval Academy Bridge will be closed for the Blue Angels' rehearsal on Tuesday from 10:45 a.m. until 1 p.m. and from 1:45 p.m. until completion of rehearsal (approximately 4 p.m.). For their demonstration on Wednesday, the Bridge will be closed from 1:45 p.m. until the show is over (approximately 4 p.m.). Tuesday and Wednesday, Gate 8 will remain open to staff, faculty, residents and high priority case-by-case delivery vehicular traffic. Gates 1 and 3 will remain open for pedestrian traffic but will be closed to vehicular traffic.

Security Information

All persons over 16 years of age are required to present a picture ID card for entry into the Academy. All vehicles and persons are subject to search.

Traffic, Parking and Pedestrian Rules

The Academy gates are closed to vehicles without Department of Defense decals or handicapped placards. Parking restrictions are strictly enforced in red curb zones. Only official vehicles may park by white curbing.

Speed limit on USNA is 15 miles per hour or as posted. All traffic must yield to midshipmen marching in formation and pedestrians in crosswalks. Seat belt usage is required at the Naval Academy, for front and back seat occupants. The Naval Academy Bridge (Route 450) will be closed during the Blue Angels' circle and arrival, both during rehearsal May 22 and for their flight demonstration May 23. Earphones may not be worn on the Academy while walking, jogging, bicycling, or driving a vehicle. Roller skating/blading is not allowed on Naval Academy grounds. Animals should not be brought on Academy grounds during Commissioning Week. Possession and consumption of alcohol on Academy grounds is forbidden.

Guest Attire Guidelines

Informal

Military women and men: Summer White; officers of other services will wear the corresponding uniform of their service

Civilian women: Suits; street length, mid-length long skirts or dresses as current styles dictate; pantsuits

Civilian men: Business suit

Children: Attire to correspond with adults

Formal

Military women and men: Dinner Dress White Jacket; officers of other services will wear the corresponding uniform of their service

Civilian women: Long formal gowns, dressy cocktail suits, dressy cocktail dresses

Civilian men: Black tie; tuxedo

Children: Attire to correspond with adults

Casual

Military women and men: Summer White; officers of other services will wear the corresponding uniform of their service

Civilian women: Slacks, walking shorts, capri pants, sporty skirts, sundresses

Civilian men: Khakis, polo or sports shirts, walking shorts

Children: Attire to correspond with adults

Park at Stadium; Take the Shuttle to USNA

Due to extreme congestion downtown and at USNA, only cars with DOD stickers and handicapped tags (display your handicap placard) will be permitted on the yard. Parking will be provided at the Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium. Families of 1/C midshipmen will be given one vehicular parking tag (rear view mirror type) that must be displayed for free parking at the stadium during Commissioning Week. All other guests/visitors must pay the daily parking fee (\$5/car and \$10/RV). All Commissioning Week parking will be on the Blue (West) Side of the stadium, with entry and egress through Gate #5 on Taylor Avenue. No overnight parking is permitted at the stadium. On graduation day (May 25) parking, opening at 6 a.m., is free for those with graduation tickets, on a first come, first serve basis. ALL stadium gates will open at 7 a.m. on graduation day.

Shuttle Bus Schedule

Shuttle buses will operate to and from the Navy Marine Corps Memorial Stadium and USNA during the following times:

Monday-Thursday, May 21-24	6 a.m.-10 p.m.
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During these hours one bus will make stops at Alumni Hall, Preble Hall, Dahlgren Hall, Visitors Center and Luce Hall (by the Midshipmen Store Parking Lot) at approximately 30-minute intervals. The best and primary location to meet a bus for transportation to and from the stadium is Alumni Hall or Luce Hall as a secondary location where additional buses will drop off and pick up.

Due to Blue Angels flight regulations, the ONLY pick-up point for passengers for the Stadium will be in front of Alumni Hall during the following hours:

Tuesday, May 22	noon - 5 p.m.
Wednesday, May 23	11 a.m. - 6 p.m.

No shuttle buses will operate on graduation day, Friday, May 25, unless weather dictates that the ceremony be moved into Alumni Hall. If that occurs, buses will run from the stadium to Alumni Hall for the indoor ceremony ticket holders only. Stadium Gates

All gates open at 7 a.m., with the exception of Gate D which opens at 6 a.m. Gate D is for press only at 6 a.m. and will be run by USNA Security. At 7 a.m., Gate D will become an entry gate like all others.

The Blue Side of the stadium contains gates	A, B, C, D
The Gold Side of the stadium contains gates	M, N, O, P

Wheelchair accessible seating at the Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium can be accessed by utilizing the ramps located adjacent to Sections 8 and 25.

Stadium Prohibited Items (items ok to bring on the Yard have an asterisk)

The following items are PROHIBITED from entering through the gates. Individuals shall be allowed entrance ONLY after disposing or securing prohibited items. Furthermore, screeners will NOT "hold" items; the owner must dispose of or secure the item(s) in their vehicle, etc.

- Weapons/knives of any type, to include ceremonial swords
- Umbrellas*
- Bags larger than a typical purse (i.e., duffle bags, back packs, large camera bags, etc.)
- Mace
- Outside food or drink*
- Anything that may be considered a weapon or a threat by screeners

Attendees have been reminded that the above items, along with valuables, should be left at home or secured in their vehicle prior to getting in line at the security checkpoint.

Strollers and wheelchairs are allowed into the site after they have been visually swept. Cameras and cell phones are acceptable.

Determination of graduation site will be made early Friday morning and posted on the USNA web site or available by calling 410-293-1000. **In case of inclement weather**, graduation will be held at 10 a.m. in Alumni Hall. Only designated indoor ticket holders will be admitted. (Children under 15 years of age, unless related to a member of the graduating class or accompanied by an adult, will not be admitted to the graduation exercises.)

Outdoor graduation ticket holders may view indoor graduation at the stadium on Jumbotron via Comcast. For anyone else unable to view graduation in Alumni Hall, the graduation ceremony will be broadcast on Comcast Cable Channel 78 in Annapolis and Channel 53 in north Anne Arundel County.
