The Superintendent, United States Naval Academy welcomes applications for the position of Academic Dean at the Naval Academy Preparatory School (NAPS), Newport, RI. The Academic Dean provides direction and leadership for the academic program of the school, which is chartered to academically prepare selected candidates for admission to the U.S. Naval Academy (USNA).

Responsibilities of the position. Reporting to the Commanding Officer of the Naval Academy Preparatory School, the incumbent serves as consultant and principal advisor to the Commanding Officer and the Superintendent, U.S. Naval Academy, with responsibility for the entire spectrum of activities encompassing the conduct, supervision, administration, coordination, evaluation, and implementation of necessary modifications of all educational functions of NAPS. Qualifications. The successful candidate for the Academic Dean at the Naval Academy Preparatory School will possess at least a master's degree, and optimally a Ph.D., with preference given to the following disciplines: mathematics, chemistry, physics, English, and education. He or she must demonstrate successful experience at progressive levels of educational administration at the secondary or post-secondary level and must possess a distinguished record of classroom teaching. He or she should present evidence of effective communication, experience in the quantitative assessment of student learning, and a demonstrated collaborative style of leadership and decision making with administrators, faculty, staff and students.

Terms of appointment. Competitive compensation for this non-tenure track, renewable term administrative faculty appointment is commensurate with qualifications and experience.
