Subj: WERTHHEIM FELLOWSHIPS

1. Purpose. To publish policy guidelines for the selection of faculty members for Werthheim Fellowships.
2. Information. RADM Robert Werthheim has established a fellowship program to support the research of two civilian faculty members from the Division of Engineering and Weapons, the Werthheim Fellowships. Funded at the level of \$25,000 each, these fellowships provide summer research salary support for up to two tenured faculty members selected from the USNA Division of Engineering and Weapons. Selectees may be from any of the division's departments and will be designated Werthheim Fellows for the academic year that they are selected.
3. Action. The application and selection process will occur in accordance with instructions published by the Division of Engineering and Weapons. Tenured faculty members of the Division of Engineering and Weapons desiring consideration as Werthheim Fellows shall prepare a research proposal describing their intended project. The proposal shall be submitted via their department chair to the review committee. The committee will consist of the Senior Professor for the division, the Director of Research and Scholarship, and one senior faculty member from each of the departments in the division. The review committee will present their recommendations via the Director, Division of Engineering and Weapons to the Academic Dean and Provost, who will make the final selections. Presentation of certificates formally recognizing the selectees will be made at the annual Faculty Dedication Ceremony during Commissioning Week.
