



Academy Nomination Timeline

May 1st – October 15th

Continue to build your academic resume and work on your essay:

1. continue taking ACT & SAT
2. Volunteer
3. Work part-time (even if it's just a lawn mowing or babysitting job)
4. Play sports - be active!
5. Participate in civic organizations / clubs (volunteer / run for office positions)
6. Apply for and attend Boy's State or Girl's State
7. Keep your grades up!
8. Check with Senators' office on their nomination process as well. Get as many nominations as possible.

May 1st – September 30th

June 1st

Open candidate file through admissions website of the academy(ies) of your choice. You may apply to more than one and also receive a nomination to more than one academy.

Check with the academies on their timelines and deadlines.

August 1st - August 31st

Schedule a day to meet with Leslie Churchwell in the Gulfport District Office to go over your academic resume and application progress

September 12th

Attend Academy Day to meet with academy representatives

October 15th

Deadline to get application packet and required documents to Gulfport District Office

November 1st – 15th

Schedule Service Academy Advisory Committee interview in the Gulfport District Office.

November 20th

Service Academy Advisory Committee interview and packet scores complete.

December 10th

Letters from the Congressman mailed to all candidates that interviewed to inform them of nomination status. (Letters go out no later than December 24th)

December 31st

Nominations submitted to service academies admissions office
