The Division of Information Technology Services intends to fill a Supervisory IT Specialist (Network) GS-2210-13 position in their Systems and Communications Department.

TITLE/SERIES/GRADE: Supervisory IT Specialist (Network) /GS-2210/13

**MAJOR DUTIES:** The incumbent, as Associate Director, is responsible for the development, maintenance, and operation of the entire network information technology infrastructure required for academic education, professional training, and administrative support at USNA. Provides technical leadership for and advises IT management on the prototyping, development, implementation, administration, maintenance, and life-cycle management of all centralized and distributed IT network resources (hardware and software) serving USNA customers, including all associated distribution, routing, and switching capabilities to include data center and distribution room infrastructures. Manages all aspects of projects from inception to successful completion of project including development of a formal, written project plan that includes a plan of action and milestones (POA&M), scope and effect statements, coordination and integration efforts for accomplishing the project with other projects underway, In-Progress Review (IPR) briefings to management, and compilation of lessons learned. Ensures the rigorous application of information security information assurance and administration policies, principles, and practices to the network administration process. Serves as Supervisor for personnel engaged in performing network administration project work and operations and maintenance on USNA IT systems.

Applicants should have at least one year experience as a GS-12 or higher and have a career conditional, career, or excepted service appointment.
