Lieutenant John Trezza

Lieutenant John Trezza is a native of Long Island, New York. He graduated from the United States Naval Academy in 2018 with a Bachelor of Science in Cyber Operations. He was selected for the Cryptologic Warfare Community and received his commission in May 2018. He subsequently attended Carnegie Mellon University as part of the Immediate Graduate Education Program, where he earned a Master of Science in Information Technology Strategy.

Operationally, LT Trezza served as the Information Warfare Officer onboard USS Shoup (DDG 86) from February 2022 to February 2024. While onboard, SHoup homeport shifted from San Diego, California, to Yokosuka, Japan, and proceeded to conduct three patrols as part of Forward Deployed Naval Forces – Japan.

Ashore, he was stationed at Cryptologic Warfare Activity Sixty-Six at Fort Meade, Maryland, where he served as a Battle Watch Captain at the Fleet Information Operations Center, a Project Officer for Task Force Pacific under Joint Force Headquarters-Cyber (Navy), and a Targeting and Deconfliction Officer for the National Security Agency's Operations Directorate. While at Fort Meade, he also received his Cryptologic Warfare Officer and Information Warfare Officer qualifications.

LT Trezza is currently a rotational military instructor in the Naval Academy's Cyber Science Department.
