Location: Annapolis, Maryland

Weather: 65-70 degrees and sunny throughout the morning.

Participants: Sixty-six (66) Midshipmen Volunteers, Coach Nathan Nudelman, LCDR (Ret) Casey Rayburg, Professor Chris Stachurski, MU1 Huskey

Event Summary:

On August 24, 2024, the USNA Marathon Team volunteered to help set up the Annapolis 10 miler course. The Annapolis 10 Miler, a local race hosted by the Annapolis Striders, had over 2000 runners. 66 Midshipmen, along with staff, helped organize equipment, place railings and course markings, set up water tables, and move race materials from storage facilities to Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium.

Event Summary:

The marathon team mustered in the Mid-Store parking lot at 0530 to begin accountability and shuttling midshipmen over to the Navy Marine Corps Stadium. After taking a team picture by the goat the team lined up for a 0700 start time. This race was a great opportunity to start the season off strong and get back into shape after summer training. The team had 89 runners in a field of over 2100 participants and additionally assisted in the course breakdown. The race was also supported by Coach Nathan Nudelman, LCDR (Ret) Casey Rayburg and Prof Starchuski.

Navy Marathon alumni Domani Occanse '24 (in the middle of TBS) and Katherine Mendyk '23 (moving back down from graduate school at MIT) made an appearance at the race. The team reconnected with them over memories of past races and made plans to go for joint long runs soon. 1/C Joe Chase and 2/C Helena Occanse, POC and APOC respectively for the Marine Corps Marathon, talked with LtCol (Ret) Alexander Heatherinton, MCM race director, who was also present at A-10. Tim O'Connor, former Navy Marathon Team President, '07 also made an appearance. Dwayne Saunders '14 spoke with the team following the race on his experience in the USMC.

The team ran extremely well coming off of summer training with 6 midshipmen placing in the top three in their age group. After the race most midshipmen stayed to break down metal gates, return tables, and load U-Hauls with gear for the Annapolis Striders. We finished early and returned to the yard by 1200.
