

On Sunday, 25 August 2019, 38 Midshipmen participated in volunteering and running the Annapolis 10 Miler. There were over 3500 registered for the race, and 2691 finishers. The day before, the team could be seen setting up the race start and finish area. It was a beautiful morning and the Midshipmen were excited to run through Annapolis. After running ten miles, the team helped break down and return all of the equipment to the race. The team was able to work together quickly and efficiently to load and unload all of the equipment, arriving back at Bancroft well before originally expected.
