**Race Info:**

There were 185 finishers in this year's 38th annual Metric Marathon. We arrived early (0630) for volunteering before the start of the race (0800) where we helped people park. Once the race started, there were 31 midshipmen runners and 19 volunteers who were stationed at monitors and water stations. The volunteers cheered on racers, providing them motivation and support. Many of the volunteers were Marathon Roster members who will be participating in the Chicago Marathon next weekend (October 12-13). This was the first race of the semester that plebes were allowed to participate in. It was fairly cool for the majority of the race with cloud cover.
