Participants: 16 runners, 27 volunteers, 1 Officer Representative: LCDR Rayburg, USN





Summary:

This year’s Metric Marathon was a success due to the outstanding work of the race director and Marathon Team O-rep, LCDR Rayburg. The Navy Marathon Team had 16 participants who raced the 26 km race, some whom placed overall and earned age group awards. On the men’s side, Navy’s Jack Huntress was the first man from the Navy marathon team to cross the finish line at 1:39:49, this was followed by Ethan Frank with a time of 1:50:16 and Courtney Fullilove with a time of 1:50:20, both placing in their age groups. On the women’s side, Victoria LaVeck earned fourth place overall female with a time of 2:09:45. Following Victoria was Caroline Buzzard with a time of 2:20:18. The midshipmen who volunteered on the MO are individuals who running Steamtown Marathon. Additionally we had four 4/C midshipman who ran this as their first race with hopes of securing a roster spot in the future. The movement order began at 0600 and ended at 1220 when the duty vans arrived back on the yard. The race was held at Southern High School in Harwood, MD and put on by the Annapolis Striders. They appreciated the help of all 27 midshipmen volunteers who were spread out along the course to help distribute water to runners and direct them along the right route.
