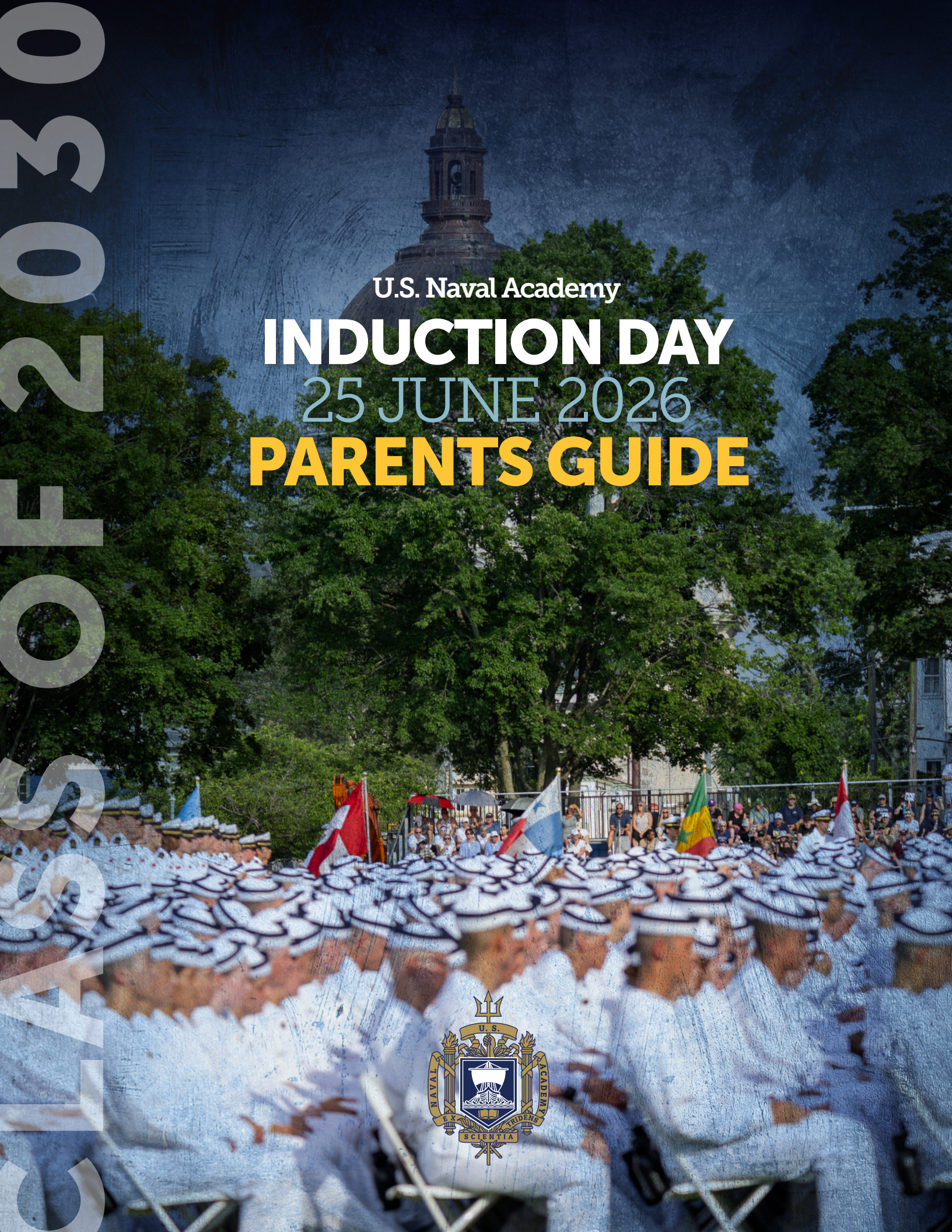

WELCOME TO THE U.S. NAVAL ACADEMY!

Rest easy, the Naval Academy Business Services Division (NABSD) will help take care of your midshipman in a myriad of ways.

During the next four years, NABSD will be an integral part of your midshipman's life here on the Yard, providing goods and services essential to Academy life. In addition to the monumental task of issuing over 450,000 items to the incoming Plebe class, NABSD will continue supporting your midshipman for the duration of their career here. Read on for the gouge on what we do each academic year.

Laundry: our staff washes and dry cleans over 1.5 million pounds of clothing.

Cobbler: our cobblers repair over 3,000 shoes, boots, belts, bags and more.

Barber/Beautician: our barbers and beauticians provide over 50,000 haircuts per year.

Repair/Tailor: our tailors alter and repair 160,000 items.

Uniform: our staff issues over 201,000 uniform items.

Textbooks: our team issues more than 85,000 textbooks.

Computer Repair: our IT team ensure laptops are up, running, and virus free.

Retail/Food/Beverage: Our fresh take on grab and go can be found at Drydock inside the lower level of Dahlgren Hall. 1845 Coffee servers and chefs provide extra fuel to keep the midshipmen going

throughout the day and night. NABSD also operates the Midshipmen Store (MidStore). This one-stop-shopping store provides everything from pencils and paper to USNA gear, tailgate merchandise, munchies, and personal care essentials. The MidStore and its goods are available to the Brigade of Midshipmen, alumni, retired military, and parents of midshipmen.

Additionally, NABSD offers goods and services to you, the public and, of course, those with a military past (or future). The Naval Academy Club features exclusive catered events in a beautifully appointed and historic venue. The Alley Restaurant provides local fresh menu items, happy hour specials, and premier access to events on the Yard. The 1845 Coffee (Gatehouse and MidStore) serves seasonal beverages and light fare that will keep the Brigade and its supporters underway throughout the year. Our fresh take on grab and go food and beverages can be found at Drydock restaurant inside the lower level of Dahlgren Hall. Navyonline.com and the Gift Shop offer real Navy gear, local merchandise, and a variety of gifts for all. Tours immerse each visitor into the beauty and storied history of the Naval Academy.

The most exciting part about these services is NABSD gives 100% of the proceeds earned to the Brigade of Midshipmen. NABSD uses those proceeds to sponsor over 140 extracurricular activities, concerts, movies, and more. NABSD's mission is, simply put, to excel in delivering goods and services to support the Brigade of Midshipmen.

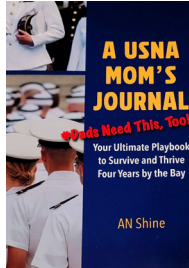

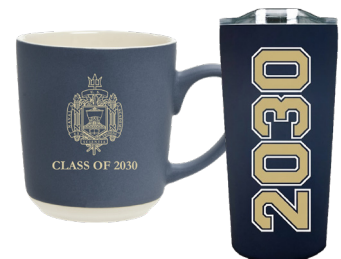

INDUCTION DAY 2026 SPEND A DAY ON THE YARD



THE USNA MISSION
To develop Midshipmen morally, mentally and physically and to imbue them with the highest ideals of duty, honor and loyalty in order to graduate leaders who are dedicated to a career of naval service and have potential for future development in mind and character to assume the highest responsibilities of command, citizenship and government.

TOURING THE YARD

Welcome! Great moments and heroes in American history are represented throughout the Yard in statues, paintings, ship models and artifacts. The Naval Academy is accessible through the Gate 1 pedestrian entrances at Randall Street and Prince George Street. Visitors 18 and older must show a photo ID. Once on the Yard, please proceed to the right to enter the Quarterdeck upon exiting security, continue along to the Visitor Center and Gift Shop!

- 1 **Armel-Leftwich Visitor Center & Gift Shop**
Visitors to the Naval Academy are welcomed as they enter the Halsey Field House on the way to the Armel-Leftwich Visitor Center. Exhibits include: photos and interactive videos of academy life; a USNA Featured Graduates display; and an Alumni Association directory. The Visitor Center houses an information desk, introductory film, the Naval Academy Guide Service for tours, the official Naval Academy Gift Shop and additional exhibits.
- 2 **Admissions**
Open to the public and potential candidates interested in applying to the Naval Academy. Briefings are hosted Monday - Saturday at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. except during Federal Holidays.
- 3 **Ricketts Hall, NAAA Ticket Office, Terwilliger Center for Student Athletes**
Tickets for Navy athletic events are sold here.
- 4 **Lejeune Physical Education Center**
The Athletic Hall of Fame, an Olympic-size pool and a wrestling arena are located here.
- 5 **The Commodore Uriah P. Levy Center and Jewish Chapel**
Supports the moral development of midshipmen, provides a fellowship hall and a reflection space for the Brigade. 2nd deck open to the public.
- 6 **Dahlgren Hall**
The Drydock Restaurant offers a quick service restaurant open to the public (Expected in 2024). Hanging above the second deck you will find a model of the historic Wright Brothers B-1 Flyer.
- 7 **T-Court**
The Indian Chief Tamanend stands watch over the site of noon meal formations for the Brigade of Midshipmen, normally held at 12:00 pm weekdays (except Wednesdays) during the academy year, schedule and weather permitting.
- 8 **Bancroft Hall**
Bancroft Hall is the largest dormitory in the U.S. The Rotunda and sample midshipman room are open to the public.
- 9 **Main Chapel**
The Chapel was dedicated in 1908 and conducts Catholic and Protestant services which are open to the public.
Crypt of John Paul Jones
One of the greatest Revolutionary War naval heroes, Jones is enshrined beneath the Chapel.
- 10 **U.S. Naval Academy Museum, Preble Hall**
The museum contains historic treasures, paintings and artifacts. Open daily (except Tuesday).
- 11 **1845 Coffee Shop**
Located in one of the oldest buildings on the Naval Academy Yard, the historic Gate 3 Gatehouse, 1845 Coffee proudly serves specialty espresso, Kombucha, various waters, and juices. 1845 Coffee also features fresh baked goods and various Naval Academy merchandise.
- 12 **The Alley at the Naval Academy**
